

Rezultati evalvacijskega vprašalnika

Učenci 5. A so v teh dneh rešili evalvacijski vprašalnik o zadovoljstvu s projektom in tu so rezultati.

Vsi učenci so projekt ocenili s 4 ali 5 točkami (5 točk je bila najvišja ocena), kar kaže, da so bili s projektom zelo zadovoljni. Večina učencev ni imela pripomb glede projekta. Posamezni učenci pa so pripomnili, da so jim jezikovne razlike onemogočale boljše sporazumevanje. Pri projektu je posameznike motila tudi dolga vožnja na Češko, celoletno opazovanje vremena, izdelava zastavic in nekaj posameznikov, ki niso bili najbolj prijazni med druženjem.

Na Češkem jim je bil najbolj všeč obisk hiše metuljev Papilonia. Tako za tem sta bila najbolje ocenjena obiska centra VIDA in živalskega vrta. Med drugim so učenci dobro ocenili tudi šolo v naravi na Vysočini, spoznavanje novih prijateljev, izdelavo zastavic in dobre sobe med našim bivanjem na Češkem.

V Sloveniji pa se jim je najbolj v spomin vtisnil skupni izlet na Vogel. Druga najbolje ocenjena dejavnost je bila skupna igra odbojke, ki se je spontano odvila med odmorom. Prav tako jim je bilo všeč raziskovanje različnih naravnih habitatov in vse igre, ki so jih igrali skupaj.

Na žalost se večina učencev ne spomni več veliko novih besed v češčini, ki so se jih naučili med projektom, vendar znajo vseeno pozdraviti svoje nove prijatelje v njihovem maternem jeziku in naročiti sladoled v češčini.

V anketi so se učenci zahvalili vsem učiteljem v projektu, saj so bili vsi zelo prijazni in pripravljeni pomagati. Izrazili so željo, da bi se še kdaj udeležili mobilnosti na Češko in bi prav tako spet radi gostili svoje češke prijatelje.

V imenu vseh učiteljev, ki smo bili vključeni v projekt, bi rada izrazila zadovoljstvo s sodelovanjem in končnim izidom projekta. Zavedamo se, da je delo v mednarodnem projektu lahko včasih stresno in zahteva dosti časa, a je hkrati tudi neverjetno dragocena izkušnja, ki obogati učni proces in tudi nas kot učitelje, zato bi se našim projektnim partnerjem radi zahvalili za priložnost, da smo lahko sodelovali z njimi.

Evaluation results from the Slovene students

Our students evaluated the project with the questionnaire on eTwinning and here are the results.

All students gave the project 4 or 5 points (5 being the highest). This means that they were really satisfied with the project. The majority of students didn't have any bad things to say about the project. Only some students pointed out the language difference which made it harder for them to communicate, the long journey to get to The Czech Republic, observing the weather, making the flags and some individual students who weren't nice enough.

The activity they liked the most in The Czech Republic was the visit to Papilonia - the butterfly house. VIDA and the ZOO were also evaluated very well. Among other things that the students pointed out as very interesting and good was their stay in Vysočina, making new friends, making the flags and nice rooms in the Czech hotels.

In Slovenia they liked the visit to Vogel most. The second top rated thing was the spontaneous game of volleyball among both schools which they played during the break. They also liked the exploring of different natural habitats and the different games all the students played together.

Unfortunately, most students can't remember many new Czech words anymore. However, the majority know how to greet their Czech friends and they also remembered the word zmrzlina (ice cream).

The students also took the chance to thank all the teachers in this project saying that they were all very friendly and helpful and expressed a wish to repeat the project and visit The Czech Republic again and host their Czech friends as well.

On the behalf of all the teachers involved in this project I'd also like to express our satisfaction with the cooperation and the final results of our interesting project. Working on an international project can sometimes be stressful and it takes quite a lot of time to get all the required things and tasks done but at the same time it is also extremely rewarding and enriches the learning process and us as teachers.
